Please read the below information before registering to become a Centre partner.

### As a Centre partner you'll be required to:

- **Provide people with free or low cost access to computers and the internet with help and support to use them**  
Centre partners are required to have a minimum of two computers or laptops and a broadband internet connection that meets the UK online centres [technology specification](#)
- **Meet the UK online centres Quality Promise providing learners with an excellent and safe experience**  
Centre partners are required to ensure learners receive a friendly welcome, are asked what they already know and what they're interested in learning, are supported throughout their learning journey and then helped to decide where to go next.
- **Support learners to use the wide range of resources, guides and short courses on the UK online centres Go ON learning website - [www.go-on.co.uk](http://www.go-on.co.uk)**  
Centre partners are required to help a minimum of three learners to sign up to our website at [www.go-on.co.uk](http://www.go-on.co.uk) each month.
- **Keep in touch and provide feedback**  
Centre partners are required to let UK online centres know about their progress, read our newsletters and take part in our evaluations, surveys, social media and forums.
- **Tell people you're a UK online centre**  
Centre partners are required to ensure that their staff and volunteers know that they are a UK online centre and become familiar with our services.

### As a Centre partner we'll provide you with:

- **The chance to apply for grant funding**  
Centre partners are eligible to apply for UK online centres grant funding and will receive free funding alerts. *Please note: UK online centres funding is exclusively available to Centre partners in England only*
- **Marketing materials and branded items for your learners, staff and volunteers**  
Centre partners are eligible to receive free marketing materials, branded items, and campaign marketing packs – to help them take part in high profile national campaigns like

Get online week. *Please note: UK online centres marketing materials and packs are exclusively available to Centre partners in England [only](#)*

- **Free training and training grants for staff and volunteers**  
Centre partners are eligible to attend a wide range of free online training session and to apply for a training grant of up to £1,000 for staff and volunteers to pay for accredited qualifications *Please note: UK online centres training sessions and training grants are exclusively available to Centre partners in England [only](#)*
- **Daily Management Information (MI) for funded provision**  
Centre partners that sign up and deliver Online basics will be provided with data on a daily basis which shows how many people they are supporting, and allows them to manage learning and analyse provision. *Please note: UK online centres MIs exclusively available to Centre partners in England [only](#)*
- **Fantastic learning resources, courses and guides for your learners**  
Centre partners can access a wide range of fantastic resources, guides and short courses (including Online basics) for your learners at [www.go-on.co.uk](http://www.go-on.co.uk) completely free of charge.
- **Inclusion on a national database of community IT centres**  
Centre partners are included on a national database of community IT centres to help members of the public find places to get online. The database can be accessed by an online search or freephone number, and is widely promoted by Race Online 2012 partners including the BBC.
